Iler Planning is currently developing the Palm Drive Improvement Plan for the City of Florida City. This plan is intended to rejuvenate the image and character of the Palm Drive commercial corridor. It is envisioned that the Palm Drive commercial strip will be transformed into a walkable, multi-modal "main street." The plan addresses urban design, streetscape standards, right-of-way improvements, landscape concepts, business assistance and land development.



Objectives:

- Create a unique, memorable and attractive public realm
- Incorporate green design into the corridor's development
- Create a walkable, bicycle-friendly "complete" street
- Increase street activity
- Energize the corridor's position as the "gateway to the Keys"
- Encourage mixed-use development and transit-oriented nodes
- Integrate design elements from the Keys and the national parks
