

VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION BLOCK GRANT WELLINGTON, FLORIDA

Iler Planning was retained by the City of Wellington to help prepare its application to the United States Department of Energy for grant funding through the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) program. The funds requested are to be used for the incorporation of energy efficient site and design features into the City's new municipal complex that is due to begin construction in October 2009.

The development of the application included the establishment of the basis for a community wide Energy Efficiency and Conservation Strategy (EECS), furthering the City's "Go Green" initiatives. These initiatives included enhanced recycling programs, utilization of native landscaping and LED lights within City parks and roadway medians, and the use of reuse water for irrigation on public property.
